This is the time of year when we count on your kindness to be the hands and feet of Jesus to the many people we serve in Northern Arizona.

Last year Sunshine Rescue Mission handed out 321 food boxes feeding 1779 people. To pack those boxes we needed 321 turkeys, 400 5lb. bags of potatoes, 500 packets of gravy mix, 500 bags of stuffing, 625 cans of vegetables, 500 cans of cranberries, 321 pie mixes, 360 onions, 360 cans of evaporated milk and 321 bunches of celery.

My name is Carlos Nixon and this is my story and how I came to know Jesus.....

I am 51 years old and I drank for over 30 years of my life. I lost my job and my relationships because of my drinking. I started to live from shelter to shelter. Then I found this one MISSION that changed my life forever.

At the mission I would listen to others talk about Jesus and how He had changed their lives.

The more I listened the more I wanted what they had and so I started asking them questions about who Jesus was. They told me to get into THE PROGRAM (discipleship) and open my heart and ears and see what will happen.

I joined the discipleship program which is an 18 month commitment. I am so glad that I have Jesus Christ in my life now. Becoming a Christian has made my life so much better. My family has heard the change in my life through the way I talk and the letters I write to them. I tell them that I should have done this a long time ago.

Every day I give Jesus praise for coming in to my life. I study the Bible every chance I get. I even share HIS word through chapel and by talking with others who walk through the doors of the mission.
